

HUNTER ADVISORY

For Anderson Island, WA (Game Management Unit 655)
for all 2016-17 Seasons

Please be advised:

There are **no public lands open for hunting on Anderson Island**. Anderson Island Association policy **requires the property owner's written permission for entrance upon private property** for any purpose, including hunting. WDFW regulations require that property owner's written permission be on your person while hunting.

Pierce County regulations **prohibit hunting or the use of a weapon of any kind anywhere within the perimeters of the Riviera Community Club**.

Anderson Island Park and Recreation District regulations **prohibit any hunting or trapping, or the discharge of a firearm or bow & arrow in any Island park**. The Anderson Island Cemetery District prohibits hunting within the Island Cemetery.

Pierce County regulations **prohibit the discharge of a firearm within 500 feet toward any building** occupied by people or domestic animals, or combustible materials; **or within 1000 feet toward a school**; or on County property including a public dump site (property bordered by Stephensen and Camus Rds., 94th St., Elementary School and Island parks grounds).

WDFW hunting regulations designate Anderson Island as a **Firearms Restriction Area** and **restrict hunters to the use of archery, shotgun, muzzleloader or revolver-style pistol anywhere at any time on Anderson Island**. Modern rifles or pistols may not be used in the field to hunt **or to dispatch game**.

Firearms, trespass and hunting regulations are strictly enforced.
